YOU ARE CALLED TO BLESS

Icebreaker/Introduction

'A Buncha Bests' is an activity that ties in with Todd's points about making an impact and leaving a legacy. The instructions are pretty self-explanatory.

Read Ephesians 2:10 (recall that Todd pointed out that this message focuses on 'the good things He planned for us") **Ask if there was anything from this week's message that stood out – either a point that was made that really resonated with them, or perhaps a question or difficulty that came up for them.**

Also Colossians 3:17, Galatians 1:15

Todd reminded us that God has created each of us as a unique work of art. What are some things that make you unique? How can we make menial tasks meaningful? (Todd talked about do things out of love for God, but how does that work on a practical level, especially with jobs like a factory worker where there may not seem to be a real obvious connection with helping)

WHAT WILL HAPPEN IF I USE MY LIFE TO SERVE AND BLESS OTHERS?

1. IT WILL CREATE JOY IN MY LIFE

Focuses on Philippians 2:17 Also Philippians 4:4-5a, 1 Peter 4:10

What are some examples from your life where you've experienced joy from serving? What is one new way that you could serve others (at home, work, church, the world)?

2. IT WILL IMPROVE MY RELATIONSHIPS

Focuses on Proverbs 13:10a Also Matthew 20:28, Romans 14:18, Proverbs 11:25, 11:17, 22:9

Have you found it to be true that relationships do improve when you focus on putting more into them? Is there a limit to how much we can give in a relationship?

Todd pointed out that one of the main purposes of our life is to learn how to be unselfish and that we can do this by copying Jesus life. Recall some ways that Jesus treated people that may be helpful for us to remember for serving others. How did this impact on the relationships that he had with people?

3. IT WILL MAKE MY LIFE MORE MEANINGFUL

Focuses on Mark 8:35 Also 1 Corinthians 15:58

What are some ways that people use to try to find meaning in their lives? What are some that you have tried?

1 Corinthians 15:58 speaks of working 'enthusiastically.' How can we develop that kind of attitude?

Read Matthew 25:31-46. Todd emphasized that when we serve others it's not that we're just doing it <u>for</u> Jesus but that we're actually doing it <u>to</u> Jesus. Discuss this difference and what it can actually mean for our serving. (can we see Jesus in others?)

4. IT WILL LEAVE A LEGACY

Focuses on Proverbs 10:7 Also Matthew 20:26, Hebrews 6:10, John 12:26

Todd shared about writing a letter to a friend who had made a significant impact on his life called "The Legacy of Peter McNeilly." Who is someone to whom you could write this kind of letter? What would you say? Would you consider actually doing it and delivering it to bring encouragement to them?

What would you hope others might write about you? (ie. what legacy would you like to leave?)

Two Secrets to Gaining Joy: a) Take focus off myself; b) Use my gifts
Philippians 2:17
But I will rejoice even if I lose my life, pouring it out like a liquid offering to God, just like your faithful service is an offering to God. And I want all of you to share that joy.

<u>Philippians 4:4-5a</u> Always be full of joy in the Lord. I say it again—rejoice! Let everyone see that you are considerate in all you do.

 $\underline{1 \text{ Peter 4:} 10}$ God has given each of you a gift from His great variety of spiritual gifts. Use them well to serve one another.

2. IT WILL IMPROVE MY RELATIONSHIPS

Proverbs 13:10a Pride leads to conflict.
