Icebreaker/Introduction

The 'If I Knew I Could Not Fail' activity connects to Todd's statement in the message: 'what would you attempt for God if you knew you wouldn't fail?' Allow time for participants to answer each question (or have them pick 4, say) and then take turns sharing answers (allow people to share any number of their answers if time allows)

Ask if there was anything from this week's message that stood out – either a point that was made which really resonated with them, or perhaps a question or difficulty that came up for them.

Todd talked about the kind of person that God uses. Share about someone that you feel God has used – either personally in impacting your own life, or someone who may be more well-known.

Consider Romans 4:20 – Does your example from the last question fit into this idea that Todd pointed out about faith - they were not afraid to trust God completely?

This passage also emphasizes that Abraham's faith grew stronger. Do you feel that your faith is growing stronger? Why or why not might that be.

Todd said that he could preach a full year on how to grow in faith but was focusing on 4 ways in this message. Before considering this week's points discuss ways that Christians can grow in their faith. Try to be practical.

1. FAITH IS CHOOSING GOD'S DREAM FOR MY LIFE

Focuses on Proverbs 29:18, Ephesians 3:20, Jeremiah 32:27, Psalm 2:8

Discuss Todd's statement: "dreaming is an act of faith." (everything we see in the world started as an idea)

3 ways to find God's vision for your life: a) Dare to ask b) Believe God's promises c) Think of something bigger than yourself

What do you think of Todd's idea about setting a bigger vision for your life and then taking longer to accomplish it?

Todd said that "you haven't really trusted God until you've attempted something that you couldn't achieve through your own power."

Do examples of this for you pop to mind? How often does this happen for you?

Consider Todd's question: "What would you attempt for God in 2016 if you knew you couldn't fail?"

2. FAITH IS BEING WILLING TO RISK FAILURE

Focuses on Acts 15:26, Daniel 3:17-18, Proverbs 29:25, Galatians 6:4

How much of a risk taker are you? Have you ever needed to risk anything for God?

Share about a time when you went ahead and did something even though you were afraid.

2 ways to eliminate fear of failure: a) Redefine failure b) Never compare yourself

Can you recall how Todd said to redefine failure? (that it's not being unable to attain a goal, but not having one in the first place)

Do you find these 2 suggestions helpful?

Todd reminded us that God calls us to be the best we can be – taking into consideration our gifts, abilities and experiences. How can this be helpful in realizing we should not compare ourselves to others?

3. FAITH IS EXPECTING GOD TO USE ME

Focuses on Philippians 1:20, Matthew 9:29, 2 Corinthians 6:8, Hebrews 11:1

Do you think people who are given big dreams by God can also struggle with a big ego?

How does God keep you humble?

Do you agree with the idea that if you have more success then you experience more criticism?

Discuss Todd's statements that we are all a collection of strengths and weaknesses and that humility is not denying your strengths but is being honest about your weaknesses.

Todd pointed out that Hebrews 11:1 encourages us to be "confident and assured" about the dream God has given. He asked, "Do you feel that? And if not, why not?"

4. FAITH IS NEVER GIVING UP

Focuses on Psalm 31:24, Psalm 119:109, Proverbs 24:16, Galatians 6:9, Mark 9:24

Do you think it's true that most people today want to do what is convenient, comfortable or popular? Todd said the world needs people of compassion, consistency, character and competence – how rare is that? Can you think of some examples?

Read and discuss Psalm 119:109. What parts of life may hang in the balance? What does it mean to 'not stop obeying your instructions'?

Discuss Todd's statement that 'God works in your life according to your faith.'

What do you think of Todd's challenge to get up each morning and asking God: "what can I do today that will require faith?"

Proverbs 24:16 The godly may trip seven times, but they will get up again.

Galatians 6:9 So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.
